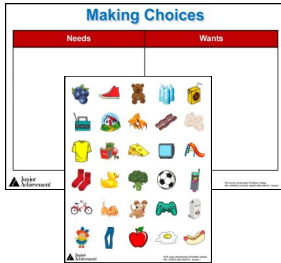


Our Money

Pre-Kindergarten



Session 1 - Choice

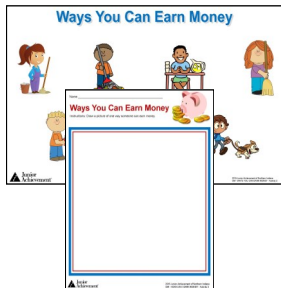
Objective: Understand the meaning of choice and balance needs and wants to help them guide their choices.

Students will listen to *Good for Me and You* read by the volunteer. The students will differentiate between pictures that are needs and pictures that are wants.

Session 2 - Value

Objective: Learn the meaning of value. Understand everything has a value that affects choices.

The volunteer reads *The Best Show and Share*. The students look at pictures based on things they value and cut and paste them in a Things I Value Booklet.



Session 3 - Earning Money

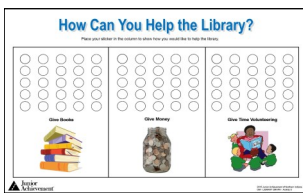
Objective: Discover that working a job or completing a task are some of the different ways to earn money.

The Best Yard Sale is read to the students. The students will differentiate between activities that could earn money (chores) and activities that do not earn money.

Session 4 - Spending and Saving

Objective: Learn the importance of waiting to spend money on wants.

Volunteers read *Just Saving My Money*. The students will create spending and saving “banks” to use at home.



Session 5 - Sharing

Objective: Learn the importance of sharing within a community and discover different ways to share.

Students listen to *Just Critters Who Care*. Volunteers and students discuss different ways to donate to the local library.
