- ALL participants must sign a liability waiver.
- Participants under the age of 18 must have a Parent/Legal Guardian sign their waiver.
- Participants the ages of 12 and under must participate with a Parent/Legal Guardian the entire length of the race.
- Participants are also required to know how to swim.
- This is a FUN 5K obstacle course, not a speed event. Prizes for those who want to test their speed.
- Invite family and friends to cheer you on. Bring chairs, blankets, and snacks.
- Wear comfy clothes that can get wet and muddy. Showers available on site to rinse off.
- Held on the trails of the scenic 1,200-acre Anthony Wayne Scout Reservation (Camp Chief Little Turtle) at 2282 West 500 South, Pleasant Lake, Indiana, in Steuben County, 10 minutes of I-69, exit 340.
- The Muddy Trail Run will occur rain or shine. Rain will simply add to the fun!
